



Festival Adjudicator Application

The Southern California Vocal Association was founded in 1939 to advance choral music in Southern California. Beginning with choral festivals, SCVA events have expanded to include honor choirs, a vocal solo competition, and specialized festivals for small ensembles, barbershop, show choir, and vocal jazz/contemporary a cappella. Festivals remain central to the purpose of SCVA with SCVA sponsoring approximately 50 choral festivals each year that are attended by over 12,000 students.

3. Attend any SCVA Festival of your choosing; see the complete festival list on the SCVA website.
4. Adjudicate each choir participating in the festival. Complete one adjudication form for each ensemble. Please ensure that written comments are correlated to items marked + or – on the right. Octavos of repertoire performed in the festival are not provided for adjudicator applicants.
5. Obtain a program from the festival you attend.
6. Obtain the festival host's signature on this form.
